## THE MORCOM SCHOLARSHIP

### INTRODUCTION:

The Morcom Scholarship was established by a deed of gift by Ellinor Morcom in 1999 to assist a student from the Ballarat area. Ellinor served tirelessly in the arts, especially music, in the Ballarat area over many years.

Under the deed of gift for this significant scholarship, the following conditions apply:

Applicants must

- be admitted to study or be a current student at the University of Melbourne including the Victorian College of the Arts
- be admitted to or be a current resident at Ormond College
- ordinarily reside within 60kms of the Ballarat CBD

Previous recipients are eligible to reapply.

To date the Scholarship has assisted students with interests and ability in the arts, especially music, in recognition of Ellinor Morcom's particular gifts and influence. Preference will be given to applicants with interest and skills in the arts area.

Successful applicants will be asked to work with the College's partner in this Scholarship – the Ballarat Arts Foundation (BAF) – to promote the award and participate in possible opportunities for shared arts activities between the College and the Ballarat Arts Foundation.

All scholarship applications are dealt with by the College Admissions Office – there is no separate application form or process.
